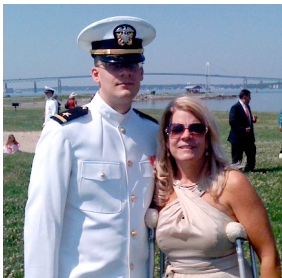


President's Farewell Message
